Explore Arts Award

An entry level qualification in art.

Bronze Arts Award

Students undertaking the Bronze qualification grow their arts interests, looking into future careers.

Silver Arts Award

Students undertaking Silver Arts Award will develop both their artistic talents and organisation skills and take on an arts leadership role.

Gold Arts Award

Gold Arts Award expands young people's artistic horizons. Through hands-on work experience and project leadership, career path planning and exploring topical arts

Bronze: Level 1 qualification on the Regulated Qualifications Framework (RQF) and typically takes 40 guided learning hours and 20 independent learning hours to complete (60 hours total qualification time).

Silver Level:2 qualification on the Regulated Qualifications Framework (RQF) and typically takes 60 guided learning hours plus 35 independent learning hours to complete (95 hours total qualification time).

Gold Level 3 qualification on the Regulated Qualifications Framework (RQF) and typically takes 90 guided learning hours plus 60 independent learning hours to complete (150 hours total qualification time).
